MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into on the 13th day of April, 2022, at Krishnanagar

BY and BETWEEN

- (1) SUDHIRANJAN LAHIRI MAHAVIDYALAYA, P. O. – Majdia, P. S. – Krishnanagar, District – Nadia, West Bengal, PIN – 741507, represented by the Teacher in charge, hereinafter called and referred to as the FIRST PART AND
- (2) KRISHNAGAR WOMEN'S COLLEGE, Aurobinda Sarani, Krishnanagar, Nadia, West Bengal, PIN – 741101, represented by the Principal, hereinafter called and referred to as the SECOND PART.

WHEREAS both the parts agreed to abide by the Memorandum of Understanding in the greater interest of the society, the draft form of terms and conditions has been framed in discussion with each other. The areas of cooperation may include, subject to mutual consent, any desirable and feasible activity that would further the goals of each institution. Such interaction may include cooperation in a variety of joint academic and educational activities such as exchange of faculty and students, based on need and reciprocity; joint conferences and workshops; joint research and publication; team taught courses, including online courses; visits by faculty and others; rendering multiple services to the community; cultural and extracurricular activities. However, any desirable and feasible activity that would be beneficial in futhering the goals of each institution may be taken into account.

NOW THIS MEMORANDUM WITNESSETH AND THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AND DECIDE as follows:

1. Academic activities: Both the Parties will share academic resources, whatsoever each party own or possess, or hold in the capacity of its own discretion, and enrich each other academically. It may include exchange of faculty and students, joint-venture in seminars and workshops, exchange of books and journals, sharing of one's achievement in other's benefit etc. The range and variety of such academic activities may be reviewed and modified from time to time during the tenure of the MOU.
2. Research and Development: Excellence of any institute of higher studies is measured not only in terms of its academic achievement and educational programme, but by its contribution to the larger society. For this research and development programme should be undertaken to promote quality of education. Joint-venture projects, knowledge-sharing and interdisciplinary research are the milestones to success in the modern world. So both the parties agree to promote collaborative research and development programme to achieve academic as well as educational excellence. It may include Faculty Development Programme (FDP), sharing expertise, and undertaking research projects on local history and culture, biodiversity, change in socio-economic pattern, partition and border, rivers and water bodies, and environmental issues at local scale.
3. Extra-Curricular Activities: For all round development it is necessary to promote extra-curricular activities such as sports, youth parliament, social service, arts, hobbies, educational clubs, recitation, debate, impromptu speech, enacting a play and cultural functions. Such activities complement academic development. Both the colleges hereby agree to organize jointly some co-curricular activities throughout the session and thereby strengthen the cultural atmosphere of the colleges.
4. Outreach Activities: Both the colleges hereby agree to promote outreach activities to bring knowledge and expertise on a particular topic to the general public in the forms of presentations, demonstrations, public talks, debates, discussion, awareness programme, campaign against social injustice etc. Since this is considered to be one of the significant markers of the social responsibility, both the colleges will attempt to help the weaker sections of the society through outreach activities.

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The parties anticipate that a number of these initiatives will occur during the period of this MOU. However, neither party is obligated to agree to any minimum number of activities, nor is this MOU intended to preclude either party from entering into similar agreements with other institutions.

This MOU shall be identified as the parent document of any program agreement executed between the parties. Further agreements concerning any program shall provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing, executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties.

For agreed upon activities, both institutions will make available their facilities and staffs. This MOU will take effect on and will be valid for five years from the date noted in the first line of this document unless terminated by one of the parties. Either party may withdraw from this MOU provided written notification of the withdrawal is given to the other party at least months prior to the desired withdrawal date. This MOU may be renewed for another period of years upon mutual written consent of the parties before the expiration date. Each institution will have copies of this agreement.


