On 26th November 2024, the Department of Political Science, the Electoral Literacy Club, and the IQAC of Sudhiranjan Lahiri Mahavidyalaya organized a memorable Constitution Day (Samvidan Diwas) celebration. The event commenced with a rally from the college campus to Bhajanghat More, reflecting the importance of the day.

The main program began with the national anthem, followed by the reading of the Preamble to the Indian Constitution by Koyel Mitra, a 5th Semester Political Science Honours student. Dignitaries were warmly welcomed before the lecture session. The Principal, Dr. Dipankar Ghosh, delivered an opening address, followed by speeches from Prof. Kabiranjan Saha, Teacher Council Secretary, and Prof. Shubhaiyu Chakraborty, IQAC Coordinator, who introduced the keynote speaker.

Prof. Bankim Chandra Mandal delivered a thought-provoking lecture on the theme "**75 Years of Indian Democracy: A Critical Review.**" The session highlighted essential topics, including respect for human rights, the multi-party political system, political tolerance, democratic voting, the rule of law, governance, and citizen participation. The lecture concluded with an engaging Question and Answer session involving students and faculty.

The event also featured an Open Quiz on the Indian Constitution, conducted by Prof. Gouri Sankar Chakraborty. Students enthusiastically participated, answering 25 questions, with correct answers rewarded with pens. 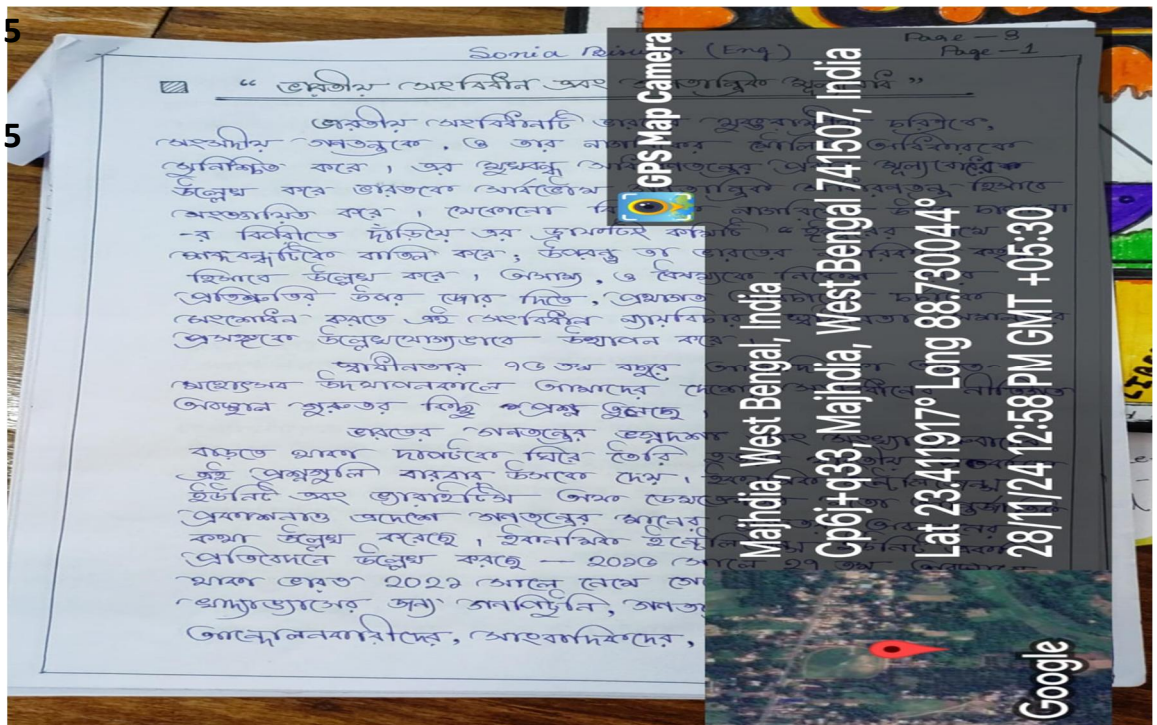
